





Spirituality & Wisdom

Social Disconnection and Fragmentation.

- Opening the School for worship and community engagement activities.
- Ubuntu Circles for guiding learners and staff.

- The school is open to people who hold church conferences. To date we have hosted four big conferences accommodating between 80 to 300 people.
- We two church services every week on Sunday and every Wednesday where people from the community are welcome.









Social and Economic Justice

 Disengaged youth, lack of agency and hopelessness.

- Working with women and girls in the community to earn a source of income.
- We managed to sell 100 laptop bags, currently we are learning crocheting and macramé. Skills to help us make different items which we can sale in different areas.

Our vision for Dema is a medical center of at least 4000 m² that offers comprehensive, high-quality services, including a family clinic, maternity ward, nursery, dental care, and a nursing school campus. This will allow us to serve the less privileged with excellence and address the full spectrum of our community's medical needs.

- Employment Creation for 28 Teachers and Ancillary Staff
- 125 Children Accessing Food mitigating Stunting
- 40 OVCs on Full Scholarships + 1

- Support for Old and Vulnerable in the community 4 Households receiving grocery support
